



**Equity in Athletics Report—Coconino Community College
Academic year 2021-2022
(Pursuant to 20 USC §1092(g))**

I. Enrollment:

In the prior academic year (Fall 2021), the college enrolled 655 full-time male students (49%) and 689 full-time female students (51%). Of these students, 4 male students were participants on men's cross country team, and 5 female students were participants on the women's cross country team.

II. Expenses:

The amount of total expenses for all teams was \$45,921. Of this amount, the amount of expenses incurred for Men's Cross Country was \$14,583. The amount of expenses incurred for Women's Cross Country was \$15,864.

III. Sports:

The total operating expenses (game-day expenses) for the sport of Cross Country was \$11,520. The total operating expenses for the men's cross country team was \$5,120 with 4 participants. The total operating expenses for the women's cross country team was \$6,400 with 5 participants.

IV. Student Aid:

The college spent a total amount of \$0.00 on athletically related student aid, including the value of waivers. Of this amount, \$0.00 was spent on aid for men's teams and \$0.00 was spent on aid for women's teams.

V. Recruiting:

The college spent a total amount of \$262.90 on recruiting. Of this amount, \$131.45 was spent on recruiting for men's teams and \$131.45 was spent on recruiting for women's teams.

VI. Salaries:

The head coach is a part-time college male employee who was paid \$5,946 to coach the men's cross country team and \$5,946 to coach the women's cross country team, for a total stipend of \$11,892. There were two male volunteer coaches who were paid \$0.00.

VII. Revenues:

The amount of total revenues generated for all teams was \$30,447. Of this amount, the amount of revenues generated for men's team was \$14,583 and the amount of revenues generated for women's team was \$15,864. There is only one sport at CCC and all revenue generated was allocated to that one sport. Grand total for all Teams (includes by team and not allocated by gender/sport) was \$45,921.
