### Coconino County Community College District Notes to Annual Budgeted Expenditure Limitation Report Year Ended June 30, 2010

#### Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

The Annual Budgeted Expenditure Limitation Report (ABELR) is presented on the basis of accounting prescribed by the uniform expenditure reporting system (UERS), as required by Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) §41-1279.07, which excludes expenditures of certain revenues specified in the Arizona Constitution, Article IX, §21 from the total budgeted expenditures.

The information reported in both the ABELR and the financial statements is derived from the same underlying accounting data. However, the formats of the ABELR and the financial statements differ. The ABELR presents budgeted expenditures, exclusions, and amounts subject to the limitation by fund type as required by A.R.S. §41-1279.07. The financial statements present the net assets, changes in net assets, and cash flows in accordance with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles.

In accordance with the UERS requirements, a note to the ABELR is presented below for any exclusion reported in the Total column on Part II that cannot be traced directly to an amount reported in the annual financial statements.

- Note 2 Exclusions claimed for debt service requirements on bonded indebtedness and debt service requirements on other long-term obligations are \$1,879,086 and \$35,429, respectively. Both amounts are included in the amounts reported as principal paid on capital debt on the Statement of Cash Flows Primary Government and interest expense on debt on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets Primary Government.
- **Note 3 -** The following schedule presents revenues from which exclusions have been claimed for grants and aid from the federal government:

Note 4 - The District does not budget tuition and fees revenue net of scholarship allowance. Of the gross tuition and fees of \$6,593,400 reported on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets - Primary Government, only \$695,203 was expended and claimed as an exclusion. Of the remaining balance of \$5,898,197, only \$261,978 has been carried forward to future years because \$5,636,219 was not eligible to be carried forward under the expenditure limitation requirements.
