**Who is required to sign this form?**

3. If parents are divorced or legally separated, the parent whom the student lived with more during the last 12 months or the parent who provided the most financial support in the last 12 months is required to complete the form.

- \_\_\_ \_\_\_ It is in the student's best interest to submit a FAFSA with the parent's income & household information. This may allow for the student to qualify for grants or a subsidized loan (which is better than an unsubsidized loan).
