

STEP 1:

Complete the [CCC Admissions Application](#)

To be considered for Financial Aid you must complete the following on the Admissions Application:

- Declare a Major - do not leave this area blank, or choose "undeclared" or "Not Seeking A Degree"
- List the month & year of your high school graduation, home school or GED completion.

STEP 2:

Complete the FAFSA

Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.gov with CCC's School Code: **031004**. You (and your parents if you are dependent) will create an FSA ID to sign the FAFSA electronically. We highly recommend that you import your tax data into the FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool when the FAFSA prompts you. If you choose not to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool when completing the FAFSA, request a tax return transcript by mail at www.irs.gov; it may be needed to complete your file at a later date.

STEP 3:

Submit Required Documentation

Check your financial aid status online at myccc.coconino.edu by logging in to **MyCCC** and then clicking Financial Aid > Eligibility. This will page show you documents that are needed from you.

STEP 4:

Accept Any Awards

Once you've been awarded, check your **MyCCC** account to accept any student loans you may have requested, as well as check on the status of any grants or scholarships you may have received.
