



How to Apply for Financial Aid

STEP 1:

Complete the CCC Admissions Application: www.coconino.edu/apply-now

To be considered for Financial Aid, make sure you declare a major that is eligible for Financial Aid. You will also need to list the month & year of your high school graduation, home school or GED completion on your application.

STEP 2:

Complete the FAFSA

Go to www.studentaid.gov to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You (and your parents if you are dependent) will create a FSA ID to sign the FAFSA electronically. Be sure to enter CCC's School Code: **031004**.

We highly recommend that you import your tax data using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool when the FAFSA prompts you. If you choose not to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, you may be required to submit tax documents at a later date.

STEP 3:

Submit Required Documentation

Once we receive your FAFSA, we will send you an email to your CCC student email address letting you know what we need from you to complete your file. It will direct you to check myccc.coconino.edu Financial Aid > Eligibility > Current Aid Year. Once all required documents have been turned in, you should expect your financial aid offer of awards in 2-3 weeks.

Scholarships:

Deadlines:

Go to www.coconino.edu/deadlines to make sure you aren't late completing your financial aid. If you submit your FAFSA within a month of the start of the semester, you will need to sign up for the payment plan to ensure you're not dropped from classes.
