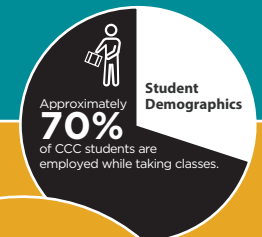

Higher national median weekly earnings for those with an Associate degree than those with a High School Diploma, no College.

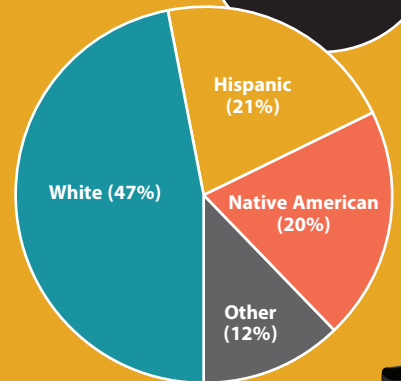
Salary / Unemployment Comparison Associates Degree vs. High School Diploma

Career and Technical education students who took a technical skill or end of program test (88%) passed and or earned an industry-recognized credential.
