What is a Qualified Applicant?

 - ▶ **ENG 101**
 - ▶ **ENG 102**
 - ▶ **MAT 140 (or higher)**
 - ▶ **CHM 130**
 - ▶ **BIO 201**
 - ▶ **BIO 202**
- ▶ Unofficial transcripts showing grades earned with pre-/co-requisites are required
- ▶ 66.1% or higher on TEAS
- ▶ Arizona LNA (or LPN) license
- ▶ Attend application session or schedule an appointment with advising or someone in the nursing department
