<i>Where are the Classes Located?</i>	<i>High School campus</i>	<i>CCC LT &amp; 4<sup>th</sup> St. campuses</i>	<i>At any CCC campus</i>
<i>Who are the Students?</i>	<i>11-12 grade high school students from 9 high schools</i>	<i>11-12 grade FUSD high school students</i>	<i>11-12 high school students (other with registrar approval)</i>
<i>How are Tuition and Fees Paid?</i>	<i>Students pay a reduced tuition rate directly to CCC.</i>	<i>CAVIAT pays for all tuition and fees</i>	<i>Students pay for tuition and fees</i>
<i>Who Provides Instruction?</i>	<i>Articulated High School instructor</i>	<i>CCC instructor</i>	<i>CCC instructor</i>
<i>When is the instruction provided?</i>	<i>During the high school day</i>	<i>2-5 pm M-TR (can vary depending on course availability)</i>	<i>Anytime a CCC class is offered</i>
<i>How are classes designated within the programs?</i>	<i>Classes are offered based on an articulation agreement between CCC and the high school</i>	<i>Classes are part of an approved 1-2 year Program of Study. Each class section only has CAVIAT students enrolled but may be linked to an existing adult section.</i>	<i>Classes are limited to 8 hours per term and must be approved by HS counselor and CCC advisor for enrollment.</i>
