**Sponsor: Institutional Research**

### **Purpose**

The College approves research involving its students, employees or facilities, including the protection of human participants.

### **Definitions**

### **Procedure**

Any party conducting research on behalf of the College submits the Intent to Research Application Form.

Research proposals must be consistent with the College's mission.

Applications are reviewed using criteria published by the Institutional Research Department.

The Research Integrity Committee is an ad hoc committee that is called together by the Institutional Research Department to review and make recommendations on proposed research.

Research cannot begin until formal written approval is granted by the Director of Institutional Research.
