A. Identification:

1. Subject Area: Art (ART)
2. Course Number: 298
3. Course Title: Introduction to Figure Drawing
4. Credit Hours: 1
5. Course Description: Introduction to drawing the human form from the live model using pencil and other media of the student's choice. Students provide paper and drawing supplies. Instruction in basic methods of drawing a convincing figure using line and value (shading). Instructor provides individual assistance daily. May be taken for S/U credit with instructor approval.

B. Course Goals: Students develop accurate perception of the human form and skill in drawing the figure on paper.

C. Course Outcomes

Upon successful completion of this course, student will:

1. demonstrate knowledge of basic human anatomy;
2. demonstrate awareness of scale and placement of the figure;
3. and demonstrate use of value to create a sense of solid form.

D. Course Outcomes Assessment will include:

1. course grades determined by the instructor as outlined in the class syllabus;
2. correct proportion: 80%;
3. scale and placement on the paper: 10%
4. and development of values: 10%.

E. Course Content will include:

1. basic proportions of the human form;
2. methods of measurement;
3. foreshortening;
4. composition;
5. and rendering values.
