#### A. Identification:

1. Subject: Sociology (SOC)

2. Course: 289

3. Course Title: Internship I

4. Credit Hours: 1-6

5. Course Description: Student's opportunity to gain experience in the application of knowledge and skills as it relates to sociology, in an appropriate setting. Pre-requisite: ENG 101 and SOC 101. Co-requisite: ENG101. One to six variable lab.

#### B. Course Goals:

The internship is a cooperative agreement between the Community college and the student. A program internship designed to provide students with an opportunity to gain experience in a practice setting, while promoting critical writing and thinking. Responsibilities of all parties will be set forth in an "Internship Agreement Packet".

#### C. Course Outcomes: Students will:

- 1. collaborate with their internship supervisor and faculty to complete the Internship Packet, ensuring all parties are informed;
- 2. complete assignments and expectations set forth in their written "Internship Agreement";
- 3. complete weekly logs on hold regular discussions on performance and assignment with supervisor and/or faculty;
- 4. follow rules and procedures in sponsoring agency;
- 5. uphold Coconino Community College mission;
- 6. meet as required with faculty, see internship agreement;
- 7. complete internship paper/project;
- 8. and provide final review paperwork when internship is complete.

## D. Course Outcomes Assessment will include:

- 1. completed project mutually agreed upon by the student, supervisor, and faculty member of record;
- 2. and a critical writing assignment to address the sociological application during the internship.

### E. Course Content will include:

- 1. written agreement between faculty, sponsoring agency, and student;
- 2. a focused program initiative, assessment design, and follow-up;
- 3. and ensure the internship has an applied academic focus.
