Assuming a student has demonstrated minimal proficiency in ASL (see admissions criteria) by end of spring semester:

Fall - year 1

- ASL 110, Intro to Deaf Studies (3)
- ASL 203 American Sign Language V (4)

Spring - year 1

- ASL 211 Fingerspelling & Numbers (3)
- ITP 210 Intro to Professional Interpreting & Ethics (3)

Summer - year 1

- Service Learning opportunity w/ NAU summer enrichment program

Fall - year 2

- ITP 213 Consecutive Interpreting (4)
- ASL 212 Linguistics & Grammar (4)
- ITP 289* Internship, Clinical Field Experience (1 credit)

Spring – year 2

- ITP 214 Simultaneous Interpreting (4)
- ITP 215 Transliterating (3)
- ITP 289 Internship, Clinical Field Experience (1-2 credits)

Summer – year 2

- ITP 289 Internship, Clinical Field Experience (1-3 credits)

Fall - year 3

- ITP 111 Interpreting Elective (2) or
- ITP 216 Educational Interpreting (3)
- ITP 217 Interpreting Seminar (capstone course) (3)
- Graduation
